Main Activities

We intend to:

- *recruit a cohort of people interested in music to form, organise and sustain a symphony orchestra in the long term;*
- *maintain the resources required for orchestral performances such as a number of centrally held instruments and hardware;*
- *organise 3 public concerts per year, together with rehearsals;*
- *organise and run educational workshops for local students;*
- *fund and implement the Young Musician of the Year JSO Award.*

Delivery of Activities

On a concert by concert basis:

- *Book the concert venue, and liaise with them on ticket sales, auditorium layout, technical systems, etc.;*
- *Appoint and negotiate fees for a suitable Conductor, Soloist(s) and Orchestral Leader as necessary;*
- *Invite local players to participate and commit to rehearsals;*
- *Invite visiting players to complete any deficit in required players via our UK contact;*
- *Arrange travel and hosted accommodation for visiting players;*
- *Run a rehearsal for local players 2-3 weeks before full rehearsals begin;*
- *Run 5 rehearsals on consecutive days before and including the day of the concert;*
- *Operate an educational programme for local student players using our professional Conductor, Soloist and/or Orchestral Leader as appropriate;*
- *Invite local charities to participate in programme selling (Jersey Scouts) and foyer entertainment (Salvation Army), and to undertake retiring collections.*

Annually:

- *Implement the Young Musician of the Year JSO Award, liaise with the Jersey Music Service, provide an adjudicator for the event, and make the presentation.*

Draft public benefit statement

We offer local players who have reached a high standard of proficiency the chance to continue and develop their skills on the island.

We regularly invite local choirs and solo performers to collaborate in performances, offering a platform for their activities and the chance to work with and learn from professionals of international standing.

We use these musicians to mount 3 large-scale concerts per year, each with a different character, to appeal to a wide range of musical tastes.

We invite celebrity guest performers from time to time, both to provide national-level excellence in a local setting and to help introduce orchestral music to inexperienced local audiences.

We offer islanders the chance to hear a full-sized symphony orchestra of 60 or more players in a local setting, normally only available by travelling to a city.

We aim at and achieve a near-professional standard.

We offer the Young Musician of the Year JSO Award to a young instrumental player to help further their experience of orchestral playing.

We invite local student players to participate in Masterclasses and Performance Platforms using the expertise of professionals in the field.

For Friends of the Orchestra who pay an annual subscription we offer reduced ticket charges, and invitations to pre- and post-concert receptions
